



2018 Summer Service Trip Information

Thank you for your interest in a Summer 2018 service trip to Uganda with 147 Million Orphans! Our mission is to provide food, water, medicine and education to children in Jesus' name.

While 147 works year-round to support the people in the Masindi district of Uganda, these trips provide a hands-on opportunity to go and be the hands and feet of Jesus and to build authentic relationships with the people. If you are looking to be stretched in your comfort, transformed in your worldview, and used mightily in the Kingdom of God, come and join us on this journey!

Although this is an amazing experience, it can be emotionally and physically taxing. We ask that you prayerfully consider the following information before submitting your application.

- The total trip cost is approximately \$3,500 which includes round trip airfare from Nashville International Airport (BNA), hotel accommodations, ground transportation in Uganda, and meals while in Uganda.
- Shots are required (and insurance does not always cover them!)
- Your passport must be valid 1 year past the date that you leave for the trip.
- Travel delays are common, so it is possible that you will return to America a day or two later than planned.
- It takes about 24 hours to travel there (that includes flights + layovers)
- Jet. Lag. Is. Real!
- Electricity and Wi-Fi are spotty and not always guaranteed.
- The food is safe, but there is not a huge variety (we mainly eat chicken, fish, French fries, rice, beans, etc.) If you think this could be an issue, you may need to pack your own snacks and bars!
- Luggage is limited to one personal item (i.e. – backpack), one carry-on sized suitcase and one checked bag.
- No one under the age of 18 can travel without a parent or guardian age 25+.
- You must secure a prescription for malaria medicine.
- Most people allot \$200 or more for other expenses (i.e. – meals in the airport, souvenirs, etc.)

This information is not to scare or discourage you – this trip will likely be one of the most rewarding experiences of your life; however, Ugandan culture drastically differs from American culture and you will maximize your experience if you are able to be *flexible* and *open-minded*.
